We are delighted to offer a letter of recommendation for Instinctively Wild following the input you and your team delivered as part of our Leadership for Social Enterprise programme.

This group of learners, aged between 16 and 21, were either referred by external agencies or signed up themselves, creating a diverse range of learning needs and aspirations. Several of the young people had recognised medical conditions including ADHD and OCD which presented additional challenges for tutors and external providers as well as the other learners.

The Instinctively Wild team recognised the importance of tailoring their input to accommodate each and every individual's needs, whilst aligning their input to the programme goals of improved communication and team-working skills, all the while demonstrating the importance of self leadership.
